

ARTICLE 1.900 FINES AND SPECIAL EXPENSES

(a) All special expenses described in Article 45.06, Code of Criminal Procedure, as amended, dealing with special expenses for the issuance and service of a warrant of arrest for an offense under Article 38.11 of the Penal Code, or under Section 149 of the Uniform Act Regulating Traffic on Highways (Article 6701d, Vernon's Texas Civil Statutes, as amended), after due notice, not to exceed twenty-five dollars (\$25.00), shall be paid into the city treasury for the use and benefit of the City of Abernathy.

(b) All special expenses described in Article 45.06, Code of Criminal Procedure, as amended, dealing with the dismissal of certain misdemeanor charges upon completing a driving safety course, not to exceed the actual expenses incurred for the service or ten dollars (\$10.00), which ever is less, shall be paid into the city treasury for the use and benefit of the City of Abernathy.
